"The essence of our wines stems from the close relationship between grape variety, terroir, and climate." Those words from Gustave Lorentz, the founder of his Alsatian estate, pervade every aspect of the winemaking and winegrowing process since its founding in 1836. The family's estate vineyards are nestled in the hills of Altenberg de Bergheim in the Vosges Mountains on 85 acres, where Riesling, Pinot Gris, Gewurztraminer and Pinot Blanc varieties are carefully cultivated. #### MAS DOIX

On the slopes of Priorat, Mas Doix winery cultivates 42 acres of vines on iconic Licorella soil, on a timeless bed-rock of slate. With centennial plantings of Carinena and Garnacha, among other varieties, the Mas Doix estate focuses on classic expressions with old-vine fruit. With a recently built winery designed with sustainability and energy efficiency in mind, Mas Doix stands poised to continue its legacy of making unexpectedly elegant, fresh wines with the classic character of Priorat.
